



How to Create Your Stamp & Die Cover

1. Download the free Stamp-n-Storage Stamp & Die Cover Template.
2. Print your case cover. We recommend printing on standard printer paper so that you can easily fold it in your case.
3. Trim your case cover. Start by using scissors or a *paper cutter to cut off the dotted lines.
4. Create custom labels to place on the cover. We used Avery template #5163 for the front. You can also handwrite your labels.
5. Create custom spine labels. We ordered custom 0.5”x3” labels from avery.com. Once you get your labels delivered, use the link at the bottom of this page to access a template for printing the label names.
6. Stick your spine labels on the middle teal strip, and put your larger labels on the front cover so that it covers the two faint grey lines. If handwriting, write your side label anywhere on the teal strip and use the grey lines on the front cover as a guide for your writing.
7. Insert your cover into your case.
8. Enjoy organized Stamps and Die Cases!

**Please note we recommend using a paper cutter for the most accurate cut*
